Boats & Safety

Pedal boats, kayaks, and fun on the water are just the tip of the iceberg. We bring a complete program to assure safe participation by all.

All boats rentals will have a minimum of one adult on board.

Senior staff in Red Cross WSI (Water Safety Instruction), Canoe Instruction/Training, First Aid and CPR.


A tow boat (row boat with trolling motor) is used to retrieve any stranded boaters

All Supervisors (and we encourage all of our staff) to be CPR & First Aid Certified.

All staff will go through a four-hour hands on safety course covering:

- Water Safety
- Basic Boat Rescue
- Throw bag water rescue technique
- Proper loading & unloading of guests
- Guest Safety
- Boat handling
- Basic First Aid
- Importance of maximum boat loads
- Basic Kayak skills
- Boat towing skills
- Proper lifting and moving of equipment
- Importance of guests safety talk

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- ALL boaters must wear lifejackets at all times.
- **BOAT CAPACITIES:**
 - Blue Boat (Small): Maximum two adults & one child under nine (9) per boat. No exceptions!
 - Yellow Boat (Large): Maximum four adults per boat. No exceptions!
 - Double Kayak (Large): Maximum two adults per boat.
 - Single Kayak (Small): Maximum one adult per boat.
- **AGE REQUIREMENTS:** There must be at least ONE young adult (16 years or older) on all pedal boats and at least ONE person age 12 or older on all kayaks.
- Stay on the inside of the yellow buoys. **STAY OUT OF THE FAST BOAT AREA MARKED BY THE LINE OF ORANGE BUOYS.**
- Do not beach the boat, as you may damage the boat wheel or rudder. Please return here to drop off or pick up passengers.
- Stay clear of the piers, to avoid fishing lines and old fishing hooks that hang from the pier.

Safety instructions and signage along with our Assumption of Risk waiver are utilized in all Wheel Fun locations.



Safety Equipment:

- Designated rescue boat/kayak
- Rescue ring on boat/dock area
- First Aid Kit
